Friday, February 11th, will be the day for our Valentine class parties. These will just be small parties for the students only. Room moms, please get with your teachers to see what they could use help with.

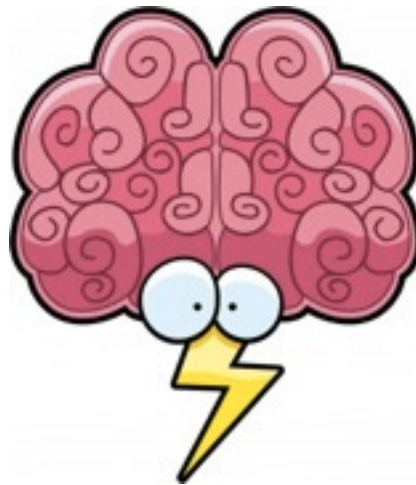
February Community Service and PreK4 Field Trip

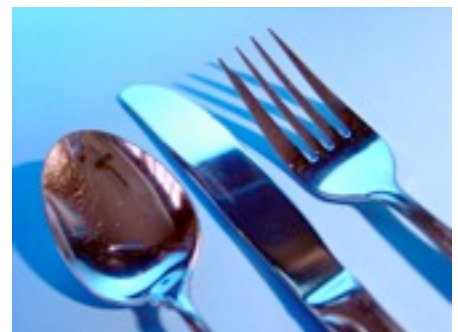

Devotional: Love

I John 4:7-8 reads, "Love one another, for love is of God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. He who does not love does not know God, for God is love." (I can hear the hymn in my head as I read it) Love for each other (its talking about fellow Christians) proves our relationship with God. Knowing God here is more than just informational knowledge of God, it's intimate knowledge. However, it's impossible to intimately know God without loving others, "for God is love". If God dwells in us, then we reflect His character. To claim to know God and not love others is a false claim. Sunday evening, a week ago, I heard a Christian brother, Chuck Scarborough, deliver a very powerful sermon on personal evangelism. As part of the lesson, he played a video in which an atheist made a statement to this effect: If you are a Christian, how much do you have to hate someone to not share the gospel with them? Wow! If I claim to know God and He is supposedly dwelling in me, my love for

others should make me want to share the gospel with everyone I come in contact with. Let's think of this every day: am I reflecting God in my love for others?
