Grade Level Expectations and Skills

Bible: God's Leaders in History, Paul's Missionary Journeys

Reading: Literature-based reading, figurative language, theme, imagery, analyzes and identifies literary elements, foreshadowing, judgments/inferences, main idea, opinion/fact, vocabulary

Grammar: Subject/predicate, sentence structure, kind, order and type, 8 parts of speech, usage, correct mechanics,

Spelling: Grade appropriate words, root words, prefixes, suffixes and spelling patterns

Writing: Organized writing, point of view, appropriate length of text, plot, setting, conflict, character development, informational writing, persuasive essays, research papers

Math: Place value to billions, expanded form, rounding, decimals, multiplying and dividing 2/3 digits by 2/3 digits, fractions, algebraic properties and expressions, measurement, geometry, tables and graphs and problem solving

Science: Stars, planets, Earth and moon, water cycle, weather, light, sound, force and motion, ecosystems, organisms
